Plymouth City stands on the border between Devon and Cornwall with arguably the finest waterfront location in the country. The sparkling seas of Plymouth Sound create a vast natural harbour, home to Britain's rich maritime heritage and now the playground of local yachtsmen and sailors. Plymouth Sound is a world-class venue for all water-based activities from Formula 1 Powerboats to windsurfing and the Fastnet Race.

The city has much to offer beyond the working day and provides an exciting range of options for free time. It has broad pedestrianised streets and a new £200m state of the art shopping centre.
